

### Federal Act on the Consultation Procedure (Consultation Procedure Act, CPA)

of 18 March 2005 (Status as of 1 April 2016)

#### **Art. 2** Purpose of the consultation procedure

<sup>1</sup> The consultation procedure has the aim of allowing the cantons, political parties and interested groups to participate in the shaping of opinion and the decision-making process of the Confederation.

<sup>2</sup> It is intended to provide information on material accuracy, feasibility of implementation and public acceptance of a federal project.

#### 4. Characteristics

#### **Participation (Characteristics)**

- The object of participation is a draft law.
- Participation has no binding effect on government.
- The typical participants are private individuals.
- Participation is a formalized process.
- There is no standard format for participation.
- Participation is not an opinion poll.
- Participation is not an expert opinion.
- Participation is not lobbying.



- Accept criticism
- Take respondents seriously
- Give respondents time
- Be patient that respondents will learn the process
