

Hans-Ueli Vogt

Hans-Ueli Vogt (*1969) holds the chair for private and business law at the University of Zurich (Switzerland). He teaches corporation law and contracts and has published books and numerous articles in his field. He has served on various occasions as an expert to the Federal Government and the Federal Parliament as well as to an international organization and he is a frequent speaker at conferences in Switzerland and abroad. Hans-Ueli Vogt is a co-editor of the "Zeitschrift für Gesellschafts- und Kapitalmarktrecht" (GesKR), a law review in the field of corporation and securities law.



Hans-Ueli Vogt worked as an associate at Sullivan & Cromwell (New York) and acted as counsel to the Zurich-based law firm of Homburger. Today, he advises companies and individuals in all areas of private and business law in his capacity as an independent attorney. He mainly acts as an expert on legal questions in the areas of corporation law, contracts and sports law, and he also acts as an arbitrator.

Since 2015, Hans-Ueli Vogt has been a Member of the National Council of Switzerland. Before, he had been a Member of Parliament of the Canton (State) of Zurich for four years.
