The work should include the following components:

 University and faculty, title, name of lecturer, surname, first name and address of author, degree programme and number of semesters, date of submission
- 2. Table of contents
- 3. List of abbreviations
- 4. Bibliography
- 5. List of materials, if applicable
- 6. Further directories, if applicable
- 7. Text
- 8. Declaration of independence, with place, date and signature:
