



Double Degree with the Universiteit Maastricht, The Netherlands

Maastricht University is a renowned Dutch university with a strong international orientation. The Master's program is particularly aimed at students with an interest in International and European law issues.

Number of Study Places:

The double degree master's programme with Maastricht University is limited to 30 study places.

The **"Forensics, Criminology and Law"** programme is an exception, with **only 5 places** available.

Minimum Requirements:

- A minimum average grade of 4.7 in the Bachelor's degree **and**
- Completion of the Bachelor of Law degree within five years.

Special Admission Requirements:

Language proficiency may be demonstrated through the following language tests, among others (subject to change):

- **IELTS (International English Language Testing System):**
 - Minimum overall score of 7.0, or a minimum overall score of 6.5 with at least 6.5 in Writing.
- **TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language):**
 - Minimum overall score of 100, or a minimum overall score of 90 with at least 25 in Writing.

Please note that, at the start of studies at the partner faculty, **English language certificates must be no more than two years old**. For applications to the Faculty of Law of the University of Zurich (RWF UZH), language certificates should generally be no more than one year old.

Duration of Studies:

- 2 Semesters at RWF UZH
- 2 Semesters at Universiteit Maastricht

Language:

Courses and examinations at Maastricht University are held in English.

Degrees:

Master of Law UZH of the Faculty of Law of the University of Zurich (RWF UZH) and Master of Laws (LL.M.) of the Faculteit der Rechtsgeleerdheid van de Universiteit Maastricht.

Important Notice: Students participating in the programme with our partner faculties are generally eligible to apply for graduation from the RWF UZH no earlier than the second graduation deadline.
