



Double Degree with the University of Hong Kong, People's Republic China

The University of Hong Kong, located on Victoria Island, combines English and Chinese law in its teaching and offers far-reaching insights into the emergent East Asian legal cultures.

Number of Study Places:

The double degree master's program with the University of Hong Kong is limited to 5 study places.

Minimum Requirements:

- A minimum average grade of 5.0 in the Bachelor's degree **and**
- Completion of the Bachelor of Law degree within five years

Special Admission Requirements:

Language proficiency may be demonstrated through the following language tests, among others (subject to change):

- **IELTS (International English Language Testing System):**
 - Minimum overall score of 7.0.
- **TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language):**
 - Minimum overall score of 100.

Please note that, at the start of studies at the partner faculty, **English language certificates must be no more than two years old**. For applications to the Faculty of Law of the University of Zurich (RWF UZH), language certificates should generally be no more than one year old.

Tuition Fees at the University of Hong Kong:

HKD 240'000-266'000 (approx. CHF 24,800-27,500) per year (fees for the 2025/26 academic year, subject to change). Tuition fees are subject to approval by the University. Please refer to the [University of Hong Kong website](#) for detailed information on tuition fees.

Duration of Studies:

- 2 Semesters at RWF UZH
- 2 Semesters at University of Hong Kong

Language:

Courses and examinations at the University of Hong Kong are held in English.

Study Programs:

The Double Degree study programs offered by the RWF UZH can be combined with any of the LL.M. programs of the University of Hong Kong, with the exception of the "*Master of Common Law*". The subject areas on offer include, but are not limited, to:

- Master of Laws (General or with Specialisations) [LLM]
 - *Competition Law and Policy*,
 - *Maritime Law*
- Master of Laws in Arbitration and Dispute Resolution [LLM(Arb&DR)]
- Master of Laws in Chinese Law [LLM(ChineseLaw)]
- Master of Laws in Corporate and Financial Law [LLM(CFL)]
- Master of Laws in Compliance and Regulation [LLM(CR)]
- Master of Laws in Human Rights [LLM(HR)]
- Master of Laws in Technology and Intellectual Property Law [LLM(T&IPL)]

Degrees:

Master of Law UZH from the Faculty of Law of the University of Zurich (RWF UZH) and Master of Laws (LL.M.) from the Faculty of Law of the University of Hong Kong.

Important Notice:

Students participating in the programme with our partner faculties are generally eligible to apply for graduation from the RWF UZH no earlier than the second graduation deadline.
