



Double Degree with the Universiteit van Amsterdam, The Netherlands

The Universiteit van Amsterdam was founded in 1632. The Faculty of Law of the Universiteit van Amsterdam favors an international and interdisciplinary approach to its degree programs, with many of the faculty members being practicing lawyers or having strong ties to the business community.

Number of Study Places:

There is no limit to the number of study places in the double degree master's program with the Universiteit van Amsterdam.

Minimum Requirements:

- A minimum average grade of 4.7 in the Bachelor's degree **and**
- Completion of the Bachelor of Law degree within five years.

Special Admission Requirements:

Language proficiency may be demonstrated through the following language tests, among others (subject to change):

- **International English Language Testing System (IELTS):**
 - Minimum overall score of 7.0, with at least 6.5 in each component.
- **Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL):**
 - For tests taken up to 21 January 2026: minimum overall score of 100, including at least 24 in Reading and Writing, and 25 in Speaking.

Please note that, at the start of studies at the partner faculty, **English language certificates must be no more than two years old**. For applications to the Faculty of Law of the University of Zurich (RWF UZH), language certificates should generally be no more than one year old.

Tuition Fees:

EUR 2'694 per year (Swiss/EU students) and EUR 25'900 per year (non-EEA students) (fees for the 2026/27 academic year, subject to change).

Language:

Courses and examinations at the Universiteit van Amsterdam are held in English.

Study Program:

The Double Degree study programs offered by RWF UZH can be combined with the following LL.M. programs offered by the Universiteit van Amsterdam:

- European Private Law
- International and European Law:
 - European Competition Law and Regulation
 - European Union Law
 - International Trade and Investment Law (selective master's programs)
 - Public International Law (selective master's programs)

A combination with the selective LL.M. programs offered by the Universiteit van Amsterdam is also possible, provided that the admission requirements applicable to the selective programs are met. Applications for a selective Master's program are submitted directly to the UvA after admission by the RWF UZH. Degrees:

Master of Law UZH of the Faculty of Law of the University of Zurich (RWF UZH) and Master of Laws (LL.M.) of the Faculteit of the Rechtsgeleerdheid Universiteit van Amsterdam.

Students participating in the programme with our partner faculties are generally eligible to apply for graduation from the RWF UZH no earlier than the second graduation deadline.
