


# Part I: Is there such a thing as legal data at all?

# **Datafication of Law (1)**

- Datafication = production and availability of computer-readable data
- Legal data?
- Law = social construct, not measurable
- But: «Double nature of the law» (Alexy)
- «Law» is also a social practice
- «Legal data» = «Law-related social facts» (Rottleuthner)
- Texts, relationships and decisions



Figure 1: Distribution of the amount awarded in respect of non-pecuniary damage (full sample)





$$log(y_i) = \beta_0 + \beta_1 V_{1i} + \beta_2 V_{2i} + \beta_3 V_{3i} + \beta_4 V_{4i} + \beta_5 V_{5i} + \beta_6 S_{1i} + \beta_7 S_{2i} + \beta_8 L_i + \epsilon_i$$

$$i = 1, ..., n$$

#### Model 1

y<sub>i</sub> = Amount awarded in respect of non-pecuniary damage

 $V_1$  = Protected legal interest 1 (life, physical and mental integrity)

V<sub>2</sub> = Protected legal interest 2 (physical liberty)

V<sub>3</sub> = Protected legal interest 3 (private and family life)

 $V_4$  = Protected legal interest 4 (personal and political freedoms)

V<sub>5</sub> = Protected legal interest 5 (property)

 $S_1$  = State: Turkey

 $S_2$  = State: Old member states (accession before 1990)

L = Victim type: Legal person



# Part III: What are typical challenges of legal data analytics?

## **Challenges**

Data quality: missings, no «data generating consciousness» of courts

 Narrowing the scientific perspective: what about normative dimension of the law?

– Identity: loss of «proprium» of legal scholarship?
