First Claim: Digitalization as Meta-Process

In the context of law, digitalization is a meta-process characterized by datafication, automation and virtualization.

Second Claim: Rise of Digital International Law (DIL)

Datafication, automation and virtualization in areas governed by international law give rise to digital international law.

Third Claim: International legal theory in the digital era

The major problems of a theory of digital international law concern the concept and normativity of law, the facts/law-relationship and the problem of disciplinary identity.
