



Double Degree with The University of Queensland, Australia

The University of Queensland was founded in 1909 as the first university in the state of Queensland and is now ranked among the top 50 universities worldwide. The Law School is also the oldest law school in Queensland. Many of Australia's most distinguished legal scholars are alumni of this school, including Mrs Una Prentice, the Law School's first graduate and the first woman to be admitted to the Queensland bar. Today, the Law School is one of the leading law schools in Australia and worldwide. With small class sizes and state-of-the-art facilities in the building refurbished in 2016, the School offers excellent conditions for students, who—alongside their regular courses—can also participate in renowned moot court competitions and legal clinics

Number of Study Places:

The double degree master's program with The University of Queensland is limited to 4 study places per year.

Minimum Requirements:

- A minimum average grade of 4.7 in the Bachelor's degree **and**
- Completion of the Bachelor of Law degree within five years.

Special Admission Requirements:

Language proficiency may be demonstrated through the following language tests, among others (subject to change):

- **IELTS (International English Language Testing System):**
 - Minimum overall score of 6.5, with at least 6.0 in each component.
- **TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language):**
 - Minimum overall score of 87, with at least 21 in Writing and 19 in each of the other components.

Please note that, at the start of studies at the partner faculty, **English language certificates must be no more than two years old**. For applications to the Faculty of Law of the University of Zurich (RWF UZH), language certificates should generally be no more than one year old.

Duration of Studies:

- 2 Semesters at RWF UZH
- 2 Semesters at The University of Queensland

Language:

Courses and examinations at The University of Queensland are held in English.

Study Programs:

The double degree study programs offered by RWF UZH are offered in combination with the LLM program at The University of Queensland.
