

Which offence(s) did Willy possibly commit? Did Willy act with negligence or with dolus eventualis?






Bob had a complicated intimate relationship with Dana. Phases of living together often alternated with longer phases of separation. When a resumption of the intimate relationship was discussed at one point after a prolonged separation, Dana made it dependent on the result of an HIV test, with which Bob agreed.






Dana therefore registered herself and Bob for an HIV test. The test concerning Dana was negative. In response to her question about the test result concerning Bob, Bob falsely stated that his result was also negative. However, Bob had not undergone an HIV test because he already knew from an older test that he, in fact, was HIV positive.






Trusting in the accuracy of Bob's statements, Dana resumed her intimate relationship with Bob. Due to unprotected sexual intercourse Dana was infected by Bob with the HI-virus.





The probability of infection through unprotected sexual intercourse is statistically low: intercourse leads to infection only in one of three hundred times.
